Community Reports

Commissioner, Karen Lipovsky, gave her monthly report including that Sharon Jefferies is now with the MSU extension and Paul Wagner is the new medical examiner for Clare County.

Nancy House, library delegate gave her monthly report. She also presented the new book about Harrison's history with pictures. They are for sale and she and Jerry Britson had brought some to sell, price is \$21.95.

Merle Harmon, Lincoln Sanitation told the board that he has sold his company to American Waste effective May30.2014. There are no changes in services and prices at this time and that he will be overseeing services in Clare and Osceola Counties.

A motion was made by Jim Korman/Dave Lawrence to adopt the policy for public comment time to be limited to two (2) minutes and that the speaker must introduce him/herself. M/C.

New Business

The township hall is rented for June 22, 2014. A motion made by Jim Korman/Barb Ferrett to compensate the trustee's for internet service at their home as the supervisor, clerk and treasurer receive compensation for this service. M/C

Public Comment

There is a neighborhood watch meeting tomorrow. A motion was made by Dave Lawrence/Barb Ferret that the township pay for an ad in the paper to announce the neighborhood watch meeting. M/C. Dave Lawrence stated that the Lily Lake Improvement Assoc. bingo may be closing due to lack of help needed. Possibly the road commission will need to get involved. Question on signs on M61 to alert drivers of the Amish buggy's in the area. Jim Korman has spoke with the road commission on this and they will do nothing. The township may look into purchasing the signs and have the road commission put them up.
